- (2) Two days into the journey, there was an explosion that caused a loss of electrical power and failure of the oxygen tanks. (3) The mission was aborted and the focus became getting the three astronauts safely back to Earth alive.
- (4) There were many dangers for the men. (5) Some of these were the limited amount of oxygen and drinking water, the loss of heating and the build-up of carbon dioxide. (6) On 17 April, four days after the explosion, the trio splashed down in the Pacific Ocean unharmed.
